Party local strength: party vote in the electorate compared to the country. Negative number (-) means party vote in the electorate is lower than for the country. Calculated as a percentage of the party vote in electorate minus the percentage of the party vote overall

Personal factor: difference in vote for MP and their party in that electorate. Negative value (-) means the party vote was higher than their electorate vote. Calculated as a percentage of the electorate vote for winner minus the percentage of the party vote for their party
